MCA PLEDGES MORE COMPUTERS FOR ALL PRIMARY SCHOOLS

KUANTAN, March 8 (Bernama) -- The MCA today agreed to widen its used-computer donation campaign to include all schools aimed at making the rural community computer-literate.

MCA president, Datuk Seri Ling Liong Sik said today the move was in line with the Multimedia Super Corridor concept initiated by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

So far, MCA had received about 300 of such computers which would be reconditioned at the Tunku Abdul Rahman College before being distributed to selected schools beginning April. He disclosed this to reporters after chairing the party's central working committee meeting here.

The selection of schools under this project would be done by MCA in collaboration with the Education Ministry, beginning with the Federal Territory, Negeri Sembilan and Selangor before extending it to other states.

The CWC meeting also agreed on the proposal by the Melaka MCA to build a non-profit making crematorium. -- BERNAMA
