NO SPECIAL PLANS, SAYS MAHATHIR ON RETURNING HOME

KUALA LUMPUR, July 22 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad returned home today and said he has no special plans to implement after his two-month working holiday overseas.

"I want to catch up with the things at home," he told reporters at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport here.

The Prime Minister was responding to reporters' questions as to what was the first thing he would do on his return home.

Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim, who served as acting Prime Minister during the two months, was also present at the news conference.

Asked if he managed to do a lot of writing and thinking while abroad, the Prime Minister said in jest: "Thinking, I can't help it because you have to think (but) writing, bolehlah sedikit."

Dr Mahathir said he is not sure when his writings (book) would be completed.
