NST photo show on Umno goes to Kedah

ALOR STAR, Mon. - The New Straits Times photo exhibition on Umno's 50-year struggle will be held at the Kompleks MPKS from Thursday to Monday.

The exhibition, which will showcase about 90 pictures taken by NST photographers between 1946 and 1996, will be opened by Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Sanusi Junid.

It will also feature 23 Lat drawings on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad published by the New Straits Times over the years.

The exhibition, organised by the NST and Kedah Umno with the co-operation of Fujicolor, will be open to the public from 10am to 10pm daily.
