OPPOSITION ALSO WANTS BRIEFING ON MSC

KUALA LUMPUR, March 12 (Bernama) -- Opposition Members of Parliament and state assemblymen should also be briefed on the Multimedia Super Corridor (MSC) project to ensure national success, DAP Deputy Secretary-General Lim Guan Eng said today.

He said the MSC deserved the support of all Malaysians and thus briefings on the MSC should also include the oppositions and members of the public.

"The DAP regrets that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad has given briefings on the MSC to only Barisan Nasional (BN) elected representatives and not all elected representatives," he said in a statement here.

Lim said the MSC could only be a success if it was made a national project for all Malaysians.

He said briefings for members of the public and elected representatives were also important to obtain useful feedback before the cyber laws were tabled in Parliament.

Meanwhile it is learnt that there will be adequate briefing on the MSC for Members of Parliament, who attend the coming session beginning on March 24.
