Park to help enhance Bukit Merah town

THE RM20 million Water Theme Park in Bukit Merah, Perak, will help realise the concept of Malaysia Incorporated, Emkay Group of Companies chairman Datuk Mustapha Kamal said yesterday.

Speaking after the launch of the park by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, Mustapha said the park was meant to help enhance the Bukit Merah lake town project as a whole.

Located on a 4.4ha site overlooking the 2,800ha inland lake, the park has become a major attraction since its soft opening in January.

It is also expected to spearhead the development of Perak's Northern Industrial Corridor, especially the tourism industry. Some 260,000 tourists have already visited the park since its soft opening.

It includes water slides, lazy river rides, wave pool, raft slides, giant wet bubble play area, a children's play pool and facilities for handicapped children.
