Perodua launches new version of Kancil

PERODUA has introduced a facelift version of the Kancil at no extra cost, available from today.

The new Kancils are part of the national car manufacturer's five-year plan which will see a new model each year until the year 2000, and a totally new "re-skinned" Kancil by 2001.

The new-look Kancil comes with a new front grille, rear garnish, washer nozzles and sporty wheel caps on the outside.

On the inside, there is new upholstery with an improved fabric. The 850cc model now comes with white-faced metres and adjustable head rest.

Perodua has also added an EX or standard version to its 850cc range. Electronic fuel injection and automatic versions of the 850cc model will be introduced next year.

The new-look Kancil will still be priced between RM24,833.74 to RM33,465.84 for the 660cc model and between RM28,900 to RM36,165.98 for the 850cc model.

They will be available in solid white and red for the 660cc models and metallic silver, green and blue for the 850cc models.

The original Perodua Kancil was launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad in August 1994.

There are now about 130,000 Kancils on the roads of Malaysia, Brunei, Malta, Cyprus, Mauritius and the UK.
