The group was briefed on the 6,400-hectare project by Berjaya group chairman and CEO Tan Sri Vincent Tan and Bukit Tinggi Resort Berhad managing director Datuk Wan Adli Wan Ibrahim.

The resort is said to be the country's biggest leisure resort which boasts a fully integrated residential resort living concept with a range of recreational facilities and amenities, as well as theme and amusement parks.

Located at 800 metres above sea level, the resort is a mere 45 minutes' drive from Kuala Lumpur via the Karak Highway.
