PM visits Krygyz Republic after Mongolia

KUALA LUMPUR, Thurs. - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will be making a working visit to the Krygyz Republic from Sept 11 to 13 after his official visit to Mongolia.

The Foreign Ministry said in a statement issued yesterday that he will be accompanied by his wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohamed Ali.

The delegation will also include a few Ministers, Chief Minister of Malacca Datuk Abu Zahar Isnin, a group of senators and Members of Parliament, senior government officials and a group of businessmen.

The main objective of the visit is to present Malaysia's views, initiate discussions and obtain a feedback on the Joint Economic Report of Kyrgyz Republic.

This report, proposed during the Prime Minister's visit to Bishek in July last year, was prepared by a team headed by the Economic Planning Unit of the Prime Minister's Department.
