PM visits Clearwater Sanctuary Golf Resort

IPOH, Thurs. - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's first stop in the itinerary of his one-day working visit to Perak was the Clearwater Sanctuary Golf Resort near Batu Gajah.

On his arrival at the golf course, he was briefed on the development of the resort's third nine-hole by one of its proprietors Tan Sri Mohamed Azizuddin.

The Prime Minister was also briefed on its many facilities like the tennis academy, fishing and boating club, BBQ and picnic areas and the Tropical Lagoon.

The Prime Minister, who was accompanied by his wife Puan Sri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohamed Ali and his entourage comprising Menteri Besar Tan Sri Ramli Ngah Talib and his wife Raja Puan Sri Datuk Noora Ashikin Raja Abdullah were later taken on a tour of the 18-hole golf course.

Earlier, about 1,000 people, including Barisan Nasional component members were at the Sultan Azlan Shah airport to greet Dr Mahathir on his arrival.

On hand were Menteri Besar Tan Sri Ramli Ngah Talib and his wife Raja Puan Seri Raja Noora Ashikin Raja Abdullah, BN components party leaders and senior civil servants.
