PRIME Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said his criticisms of the Group of Seven (G-7) countries would not foil attempts to attract investors to Malaysia, especially to the Multimedia Super Corridor.

Dr Mahathir said businessmen of these countries need not necessarily support the actions of their governments.

Citing an example, Dr Mahathir said a delegation of American businessmen who came to Malaysia had voiced their support for Asean's decision to admit Myanmar into the grouping.

He said they supported the move although their Government objected to it.
