PRM happy with war against graft

KUALA LUMPUR, Fri. - Parti Rakyat Malaysia is happy that the Government is beginning to take action against those involved with corruption and abuse of power.

Its president, Syed Husin Ali, said today although up to now the cases that had been brought to book were relatively small, the party believed the Government would continue to act more firmly against much bigger cases.
