SABAH YOUTHS GATHER TO VOICE SUPPORT FOR MAHATHIR

KOTA KINABALU, Nov 26 (Bernama) -- More than 500 youth gathered here to pledge their support for Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad as Prime Minister.

The gathering at Padang Merdeka was organised by the Sabah Youth Council (MBS) and was joined by other youth organisations in the state including the Sabah National Youth Association, Scouts, Guides, the Red Crescent Society, St John Ambulance and the Sabah United Bisaya Association.

MBS President Datuk Lajim Ukin, who is also State Local Government and Housing Minister, said other countries had no right to interfere in the affairs of this country.

He also criticised the draft resolution by 34 American Congressmen demanding that Dr Mahathir apologise for his alleged anti-Jewish remarks failing which he should resign.

MBS also highlighted several resolutions at the gathering including support for the government in setting up the National Economic Action Council to deal with economic problems faced by the country. --BERNAMA
