SENATORS EXPRESS FULL CONFIDENCE IN DR MAHATHIR'S LEADERSHIP

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 10 (Bernama) --The Senators Club of Malaysia today expressed full confidence in Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's ability to resolve the country's present financial problems.

Club Deputy President Senator Datuk Mohd Zuki Kamaluddin said members of its council which met at Parliament House today resolved to support the stand adopted by Dr Mahathir in combating the country's financial and economic crisis.

"We stand solidly behind the Prime Minister and support his government's efforts to resolve the problems being faced," he said after the meeting.

He said club members who included former senators prayed that Dr Mahathir would continue to have the strength to lead the government in the interest of the race, Islam and the nation.

He also said that they would seek to extend the Dewan Negara sitting by two days in December to enable Senators to discuss the country's economic and financial problems.
