Sitting extended two more days

THE Dewan Rakyat sitting has been extended for another two days to enable the debate and approval of eight remaining Bills to be completed.

Originally the Dewan Rakyat sitting, which started on March 25, was scheduled to end yesterday.

On May 29, Deputy Speaker Ong Tee Keat informed the House that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had agreed to a two-day extension. The House was to sit on May 12 and May 13.

Yesterday, Speaker Tan Sri Mohamed Zahir Ismail said Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim had agreed to the second extension.

The House will, therefore, also sit on May 14 and 15.
