SPEND HOLIDAYS IN THE COUNTRY, URGES KADIR

LANGKAWI, Nov 24 (Bernama) -- Deputy Human Resources Minister Datuk Abdul Kadir Sheikh Fadzir today urged Malaysians not to fly out for holidays but to spend their vacation in the country to check the outflow of the ringgit.

Datuk Abdul Kadir Sheikh Fadzir, who is a member of the Umno Supreme Council, said this was in line with the recent decision of the Supreme Council not to allow party members to go on overseas vacation.

He said to face the problems caused by the depreciating ringgit Umno members should abide by the council's decision and respect the wishes of party president and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.
