TIES WITH S'PORE WILL BE NORMAL WHEN BITTERNESS SUBSIDES, SAYS PM

TOKYO, March 27 (Bernama) -- Malaysia's normal relations with Singapore will resume as soon as Malaysians got over the feeling of hurt and bitterness caused by an uncalled for remark against Malaysia, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said here today.

Commenting on yesterday's Malaysian Cabinet's decision to freeze all fresh bilateral dealings with Singapore, he said his Cabinet colleagues must have some good reasons to take that decision.

Mahathir said as the Cabinet meeting was held in his absence, he needed to talk to his Cabinet colleagues before he would comment further on the matter.
