

# Azizah: I did nothing wrong

KUALA LUMPUR: Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's wife Datin Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail maintained that she did nothing wrong by driving to the city although it was near a pro-Anwar demonstration. 5.22.10.98

She was responding to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir's statement on Tuesday that he hoped police would not arrest her although she appeared to support street demonstrations.

"They can misconstrue anything. Is it wrong for me to go downtown for shopping? I have not committed any

offence. What have I done wrong to be arrested? I was just driving past, I didn't make any statements there," she told reporters at her house here yesterday.

A group of journalists had gathered outside her house about noon yesterday because they heard that she had been arrested.

"I don't understand the rumour. Even the PM explained that I'm doing the right thing in supporting my husband," she said, stressing that Dr Mahathir had even said he saw no justification for her arrest.
