

# Wan Azizah vows to continue movement

KUALA LUMPUR: Datin Seri Dr Wan Azizah Ismail vowed to continue the reformation movement and appealed to supporters to remain calm.

Expressing disappointment over the police action against supporters outside the court yesterday, she said she would abide by the police directive not to hold any *ceramah*.

"Anwar had been giving speeches. So I don't have to (give

*ceramah*). By now, I think the message has spread," she said.

She said the police had allowed her to hold press conferences.

She also expressed disappointment over the use of tear gas and water cannons to disperse the crowd.

She said Anwar's arrest would

not deter his supporters.

Former Parti Melayu Semangat 46 and former Umno leader Hajjah Marina Yusof who was also there said the goal of the movement was to get Dr Mahathir to resign.

She claimed that certain parties might "plant" troublemakers in their midst to create chaos as excuse to act and called on supporters to be wary of such tactics.
