

Fauzi: Rebels to face action ¹⁶

KUANTAN: Umno division members here who were involved with Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's reformation movement recently must be prepared to face any disciplinary action meted out by the party's supreme council.

Division chief Datuk Fauzi Abdul Rahman said that so far he had yet to identify those who had attended the rally.

It is learnt that the owner who allowed his house to be used as a ceramah centre in Peramu Jaya near here was an Umno member.

Fauzi said he would chair a meeting on Tuesday to propose actions to be taken against those involved in the ceramah.

He added that the proposals

would later be submitted to the supreme council.

Fauzi said the division supported Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's decision to sack Anwar from the Government and the action of the supreme council to sack him from the party. *S 27.9.98*

He regarded the decision made by the Prime Minister as wise and that it was made after considering many factors and implications.

Fauzi said his division condemned any efforts made by the "reformation movement" launched by Anwar and urged party members not to support it.

He added that the division also condemned the unruly be-

haviour of Anwar's supporters last Sunday.

Fauzi also advised Anwar's wife, Datin Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail, to think of her children before continuing her husband's crusade.

He said Dr Wan Azizah should abide by the law and adhere to the advice given by Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali.

"It is better for her to concentrate on her duties as a mother," he said.

He added that he personally felt sad over the dismissal of a close friend like Anwar.

Fauzi said he believed that Anwar would get a fair trial and urged his family to be patient.
