A WEEK'S HOLIDAYS FOR POLICEMEN ON DUTY DURING COMMONWEALTH GAMES

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 22 (Bernama) -- Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Abdul Rahim Noor today announced seven days' holidays for his officers and men who were duty during the 16th Commonwealth Games which ended yesterday.
