ABRAR GROUP DENOUNCES RAHIM GHOUSE'S ACTIVITIES

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 9 (Bernama) -- The Abrar Group today denounced the activities of former executive director of Abrar Group International Sdn Bhd Dr Abdul Rahim Ghouse in criticising the country's leadership.

"These actions are against the policy of the group and is not condoned by us," said Dr Wan Muhamad Hasni Wan Sulaiman who is Abrar Group International executive chairman and chief executive officer.

In a statement today, he said Abdul Rahim had resigned from all posts within the Abrar Group since Sept 18 and as such any of his actions had no relation at all with the group and should not be construed as its policy.

Dr Wan Hasni also said the group was not involved with or supported the reform movement mooted by some people in the country.

He said all citizens of Malaysia should give their undivided support to the government under the leadership of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Abdul Rahim made unflattering remarks about Malaysian leaders and the running of the country from abroad following the dismissal of former deputy prime minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim from the government and Umno in early September.
