ACTION TO BE TAKEN AGAINST TROUBLEMAKERS, SAYS KAYVEAS

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 21 (Bernama) -- The People's Progressive Party of Malaysia (PPP) will pass a resolution at its annual general meeting here today to take action against 14 "troublemakers" who are disturbing the party.

PPP president Datuk M. Kayveas said today that the party might approach the Attorney-General's Chambers to see how it could help to put a stop to their activities.

"They are either expelled or non-members who give out statements without the party's consent," he told reporters after the opening of the meeting by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today.

The meeting would also pass a resolution in support of Dr Mahathir and the government to continue with efforts to overcome economic problems facing the country.
