ANOTHER FIVE UMNO MEMBERS TO FACE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

KUALA LUMPUR, 16 Nov (Bernama) -- Another five Umno members will be called before the party's management and disciplinary committee on Wednesday for allegedly working against the interest of the party.

Umno secretary-general Datuk Seri Sabbaruddin Chik said there are among 11 members issued with showcause letters.

The other six had given their side of the story last Wednesday, he told reporters after witnessing the signing of an agreement between Malaysian Resources Corporation Berhad (MRCB) and Globe Facility Services Incorporated to set up a joint venture company, Arena Sentral Sdn Bhd, here today.

Sabbaruddin said that in all 25 Umno members had responded to the showcause letters with 14 giving satisfactory reply and therefore would not be called before the committee.

Last week, a former Umno youth leader, three divisional heads, an acting divisional head and a divisional Umno youth head were called before the committee.

On Umno election next year, Sabbaruddin said members would not be prevented from contesting especially for the posts of deputy president and vice-president.

He said Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had never said that members could not contest the two posts.
