BE CALM AND HAVE CONFIDENCE IN THE COURTS, PEOPLE TOLD

GRIK, Sept 20 (Bernama) -- The people should remain calm in facing the situation involving former Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim who was alleged to be involved in various sex cases including sodomy, said Deputy Home Minister Datuk Tajol Rosli Ghazali said today.

He said they should have confidence in the country's legal system and the police must have their reasons for not charging Anwar in court as yet.

"I hope the people will remain calm. Let the law takes its course. We must have confidence in the police, the Attorney-General and the courts," he told reporters after attending a ceramah by Umno Supreme Council member Datuk Ibrahim Ali, here.

Tajol Rosli said the people should not resort to actions which could create uneasiness. "I know many people still find it difficult to accept all this."

He said it was even more difficult for Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir but he decided to act against Anwar after giving the matter serious consideration in the interest of the country.
