CAMDESSUS TO ARRIVE TOMORROW

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 14 (Bernama) -- Managing director of the International Monetary Fund (IMF), Michel Camdessus, is scheduled to arrive in Kuala Lumpur from Indonesia tomorrow for a two-day visit.

A finance ministry statement said here today the purpose of the visit is to exchange views and discuss the latest development of the Malaysian economic situation.

Camdessus is scheduled to meet deputy prime minister and finance minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim at the Treasury in the evening followed by a meeting with prime minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad the next day.

He is also scheduled to have a meeting with officials from Bank Negara Malaysia and the Treasury.

Camdessus is visiting a number of Asian countries, including South Korea, in efforts to mitigate the economic crisis facing the region.

He will leave for Singapore on Jan 16. -- BERNAMA
