CHINESE FOREIGN MINISTER TO VISIT MALAYSIA

KUALA LUMPUR, July 29 (Bernama) -- Chinese Foreign Minister Tang Jiaxuan arrives here on Friday for a four-day official visit to Malaysia.

Tang, who will be here at the invitation of his Malaysian counterpart Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi, will fly in from Manila after attending the Asean Post Ministerial Conference and the Asean Regional Forum there.

A Wisma Putra statement today said the two foreign ministers will hold bilateral discussions and also exchange views on regional and international issues.

Tang will also have an audience with Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Ja'afar and call on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

He will also visit Cyberjaya where he will be briefed on the development of Malaysia's Multimedia Super Corridor.
