DR MAHATHIR MAKES FAREWELL CALL ON BURKINA FASO PRESIDENT

KUALA LUMPUR, April 25 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad this morning made a farewell call on Burkina Faso President Blaise Compaore who will depart tomorrow after a five-day state visit.

The two leaders had held bilateral talks on Thursday and witnessed the signing of two agreements on trade and investment guarantee to expand trade and economic cooperation.

Malaysia will be sending a business delegation to the West African republic to explore investment opportunities.

Among the areas in which Malaysia is interested in are telecommunications, mining and air services industries.

Compaore will be granted a farewell audience by Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Ja'afar later today.
