DR MAHATHIR IN MEETING WITH GOH

SINGAPORE, Feb 7 (Bernama) -- Malaysian Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had a closed-door "four-eyed" meeting with his Singapore counterpart, Goh Chok Tong, here today.

The meeting, at the Sentosa Golf Club on Sentosa Island, lasted some two hours.

The Singapore Ministry of Foreign Affairs said the two leaders met to continue their discussion on the regional currency crisis and bilateral matters.

The two Prime Ministers last met on Jan 20 in Johor.

Dr Mahathir, accompanied by his wife, Datuk Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohamed Ali, arrived in Singapore at 12 noon and were hosted to lunch by Goh and his wife.

While the two Prime Ministers were having their discussion, their wives went for a tour of Sentosa Island.

Dr Mahathir and his wife left for the airport to return home at about 4.30pm. -- BERNAMA
