DR MAHATHIR RECEIVES RESOLUTION ON LABOUR ISSUES

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 30 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today received a resolution on labour issues from the Asia-Pacific Labour Network (APLN) to be discussed at the forthcoming Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (Apec) meeting here in November.

The resolution which was the product of a two-day APLN meeting here last Monday was handed over to the Prime Minister by Malaysian Trades Union Congress (MTUC) president Zainal Rampak.

The APLN is a member of the 125 million member International Confederation of Free Trade Union.

Zainal, who lead the 28-member delegation to the Prime Minister's Department today said the resolution would be submitted to the Apec ministerial meeting here.

He said it was the normal process that whenever the Apec meeting was held, the APLM would submit its resolution to the host country to be forwarded to the Apec meeting.
