DR MAHATHIR AND GOH DISCUSS REGIONAL CURRENCY CRISIS

SINGAPORE, Jan 20 (Bernama) -- Malaysian Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his Singapore counterpart, Goh Chok Tong, discussed the regional currency crisis and bilateral relations in a meeting in Johor TODAY.

Prime Minister Goh's Press Secretary Lim Siam Kim confirmed that the two leaders met at the Sevana Cove Resort, some 140 km from Johor Baharu.

He said they discussed the regional currency crisis as well as bilateral relations during their 90-minute meeting.

Goh is also scheduled to make an official visit to Malaysia later.

Last Saturday, Dr Mahathir met President Suharto in Jakarta. Prior to this, Goh also met Suharto in Jakarta. -- BERNAMA
