DR MAHATHIR COMMISSIONS RM318 MILLION WASTE DISPOSAL PLANT

PORT DICKSON, Nov 7 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad arrived here today to officially commission a RM318-million integrated treatment plant for scheduled waste in Bukit Nanas, 22 km from here.

He was met on arrival by Negeri Sembilan Menteri Besar Tan Sri Mohd Isa Abdul Samad and Science, Technology and Environment Minister Datuk Law Hieng Ding.

The plant can treat all the 107 scheduled wastes listed under the Environment Quality (Scheduled Wastes) Regulations 1989.

The plant was built by Kualiti Alam Sdn Bhd which has been granted a 15-year concession period to run it.

So far 740 companies whose operations emit scheduled wastes have signed up with Kualiti Alam for use of the facilities there.
