EON waives RM100 fee for Bridge Drive

PENANG, Fri. - Edaran Otomobil Nasional Berhad today announced that Proton car owners wishing to participate in the convoy of Protons over the Penang Bridge on Sunday need not pay the RM100 entry fee.

However, non-paying participants will not be entitled to the lucky draw and will only get souvenir items. Those who wish to take part in the lucky draw must pay the entry fee of RM100.

Earlier, all those wishing to participate were required to pay RM100 as entry fee. EON hopes to have 1,998 cars in the convoy in conjunction with Merdeka Celebration.

In a statement this evening, EON, the organiser of the convoy to be led by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad from the Prai toll plaza at 5pm Sunday, said:

"In response to overwhelming requests, EON is allowing drivers with Proton cars to participate in the Bridge Drive without having to pay the RM100 entry fee. They will not be eligible for the lucky draw, however."

The grand prize in the lucky draw is a RM30,000 Proton Iswara Aeroback, the first prize is RM5,000 cash and second prize RM3,000 cash. There will also be 24 other cash prizes and consolation prizes.

Those interested should register at any EON branch, or the EON booths at Komtar, Bukit Jambul Shopping complex, Mega Mall in Butterworth, or at the special booth at the Prai toll plaza from 10am to 3pm on Sunday.
