Federal police probe six reports against PM

KUALA LUMPUR, Sat. - The Federal police are investigating six reports lodged against Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad in connection with the dismissal of his former deputy, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

The reports were lodged last Wednesday at the Petaling Jaya, Sea Park and Damansara police stations.

City police chief Deputy Commissioner Datuk Kamaruddin Mohamad Ali said today that the Federal police took over the investigation in view of the seriousness of the reports, believed to have been lodged by supporters of Anwar.

Kamaruddin was speaking to newsmen after officiating at the "Teaming up for safety at Kuala Lumpur '98" with the launch of 100,000 pocket-size police help-line cards at the Shangri La Hotel.
