IF food, music and fun are part and parcel of your life, head for a good time at Bangsar in Kuala Lumpur tomorrow at 6pm.

The Bangsar Baru business centre will be converted into a pedestrian mall for the Bangsar Carnival, held in conjunction with the Commonwealth Games.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will launch the event.

It is the PM's first official visit to the area.

Music will be provided by an 80-piece brass band. There will also be street musicians, a lion dance, kompang and bhangra performances.

Stalls will be set up to sell Games tickets. There will also be souvenir booths and food stalls.

The following roads in the area will be closed to traffic from 4pm tomorrow for the event: Jalan Telawi Dua, Jalan Telawi Tiga (up till Public Bank), Jalan Telawi Empat and Jalan Telawi Lima.

The Bangsar Carnival is organised by the Youth and Sports Ministry, Bangsar Baru Business Council, Persatuan Penjaja-Penjaja dan Peniaga-Peniaga Kecil, Cawangan Bangsar, and the residents associations of Bangsar.
