IIU to get new president following Anwar's dismissal

SEREMBAN, Tues. - The statement from the Prime Minister's Department on the position of the former Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim was clear and covered all positions held by him including that of the International Islamic University president.

Education Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak said the university had notified all shareholders of the matter.

Anwar, who was also stripped of his positions as Finance Minister and Umno deputy president, became the university's president in 1988.

Najib said he would meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad soon to appoint a new president for the university.
