Joint expo on local goods

RESPONDING to the Government's call to promote Malaysian-made products, the Subang Jaya Municipal Council and the National Singers Association will jointly organise a "Buy Malaysian Products" expo in July.

The expo, which will be held at the USJ10 field, will go on for three weeks starting from July 7.

Council president Ahmad Fuad Ismail said the expo would be officiated by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

"We are in the process of preparing entry forms for the Federation of Malaysian Manufacturers members and local manufacturers to take part in the expo," he said.

Ahmad Fuad said the expo was being organised with the aim of helping the Government to restore the economic situation by popularising local products.

"By doing this, we hope to be able to promote local products among locals and at the same time help to reduce imports," he said, adding that the State Economic Action Council was also encouraging local councils to help in promoting local products.

Asked how the council came to collaborate with Papita, Ahmad Fuad said the association approached the council at a time when it was also having the same idea.

"The singers also have a role to play in helping the Government restore the economy. They can also help to get people to visit the expo."

He said the expo would be a good start for the council in making USJ a "trade city".

"This expo will be the first big trade event held in USJ," he said.
