KELANTAN UMNO REJECTS PRO-ANWAR REFORM MOVEMENT

KOTA BAHARU, Oct 30 (Bernama) -- Rural Development Minister Datuk Annuar Musa said today the Kelantan Umno had wholesomely rejected the reform movement founded by sacked Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

Hence, the State Umno or its members are not involved in attempts by a certain group to organise pro-reform gatherings here, he said.

Umno members would not conspire with the group to organise such gatherings as they have pledged unequivocal support for Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, said Annuar, who is also Kelantan Umno deputy chief.

He said the anti-government demonstration planned to be held here tomorrow might be organised by the same group which hosted the illegal gathering at the Sultan Mohamed IV Stadium here last month.

He said members of the Malaysian People's Justice Movement Council (Gerak) or PAS might be involved in organising the demonstration.

Kelantan PAS Youth chief Husam Musa lodged a police report yesterday on the distribution of leaflets urging the people to attend the gathering termed " Peaceful Gathering of One Million Families of Reform Movement" at the Siti Khatijah Central Market here.

Husam, who is also Kelantan Menteri Besar's political secretary, said the gathering is held by a certain group to "disturb" the peace in the state.
