Kit Siang: We discussed measures

KUALA LUMPUR, Sat.- Opposition leader and DAP secretary-general Lim Kit Siang met former Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim at his Bukit Damansara residence today.

Lim issued a statement later that they discussed his proposal for an emergency meeting of Parliament and for the establishment of a Royal Commission of Inquiry.

The proposal is for the Royal Commission to look into the allegations against Anwar and Anwar's charges that instruments of government had been manipulated in a political conspiracy to topple him.

Lim said Anwar supported the Royal Commission proposal and that he (Lim) had asked for an appointment with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to convey it.
