Kit Siang: Reveal police findings on Anwar's black eye

PENANG, Sun. - The DAP today called on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to immediately reveal the police findings on Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's "black eye".

Opposition Leader and DAP secretary-general Lim Kit Siang said the Prime Minister should also demand a public explanation from the Attorney-General for the "inordinate delay" in taking action on the case.

"It is another national and international scandal that three months after the 'black eye' assault, the Attorney-General is still sitting on the report of the independent police investigation team although the report was submitted to his chambers a month ago," said Lim, who is also the MP for Tanjung.

"Will the Attorney-General now blame the new delay on the consultant forensic specialist he appointed to assist him in assessing medical reports in connection with Anwar's condition?" asked Lim.

Meanwhile, Lim supported the call by Anwar's wife Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail that Anwar be released on bail for Ramadan to allow him to be with his family.

He also called for swift registration of the newly-formed Social Justice Movement (Adil) as political parties had been registered in a very short period, some even within 24 hours.
