KNOWLEDGE, FAITH AND PRACTICE, THE INGREDIENTS FOR GOOD LEADERSHIP

KUALA LUMPUR, June 26 (Bernama) -- Undergraduates were tonight reminded that good leadership is founded on high knowledge and faith and putting the two into practice.

"Knowledge is useless without faith and even having both is useless if they are not put into practice," Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Fauzi Abdul Rahman said.

These three factors could guide undergraduates, as potential leaders, in facing the era of globalisation, he said in a talk in conjunction with a leadership seminar for students of institutions of higher learning at Universiti Teknologi Malaysia, here.

About 500 students from all the public institutions of higher learning and three private universities -- Universiti Petronas, Universiti Tenaga Nasional and Universiti Telekom -- are attending the three-day seminar opened by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad this morning.
