LANGKAWI AIR CARNIVAL TO BE HELD ALTERNATELY WITH LIMA

LANGKAWI, Nov 30 (Bernama) -- The Langkawi Air Carnival (LAC) will be held alternately with the Langkawi International Maritime and Aerospace (Lima) exhibition, Langkawi Flying Club chairman Datuk Haji Abdul Halil Mutalib said.

While bigger aircraft were exhibited in Lima, LAC would show the lighter planes, he told reporters here today.

Both events are held once in two years.

Abdul Halil who is the LAC '98 organising committee chairman said the three-day LAC '98 would be opened by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at the Langkawi International Airport on Dec 5.

He said more than 60 light aircraft from local flying clubs as well as Singapore and Thailand would participate in the air carnival.

LAC '98 is jointly organised by the Langkawi Flying Club and Department of Civil Aviation.

Members of the public need only to pay RM1 each to watch the carnival.
