#### Langkawi Yacht Club to open in September

LANGKAWI, Wed. - Langkawi Yacht Club will have its opening during the Commonwealth Games in September.

Tunku Abdullah ibni Almmarhum Tuanku Abdul Rahman, whose company Nilam Timur has majority stake in the club, said he was trying to get Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to open it.

He said the club would also invite Queen Elizabeth, expected for the opening of the Commonwealth Games from Sept 11 to 21, to attend the function.

"Since Langkawi is the venue for shooting events for the Games, we are planning to coincide our opening during that time," he said today.

The RM12 million club building beside the Kuah jetty was completed more than a year ago.

It has been attracting yacht owners, especially from overseas.

Nilam Timur, which is under the stable of Melewar Group of Companies, controlled by Tunku Abdullah holds a 70 per cent stake in the yacht club while the rest is owned by Langkawi Development Authority.

Tunku Abdullah also said that after some technical problems pertaining to the land were ironed out, the club would go on a membership drive from July.
