MOHAMED URGED TO EXPOSE THE WOLVES IN SHEEP'S CLOTHING

MELAKA, Sept 30 (Bernama) -- Information Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Rahmat was today urged to expose the Umno Division leaders involved in subversive activities to topple the Prime Minister so as to put an end to their pretence.

Making the call, Melaka State Assembly Speaker Datuk Nasir Manap said if not exposed they would escape punishment and continue to remain as wolves in sheep's clothing.

"They will make public expression of support and pretend to be behind Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad but carry out subversive activities behind his back," he said.

Divisional leaders who did not give undivided support to Dr Mahathir should resign, he said at a news conference attended by heads of 20 Umno branches in the Kota Melaka Division.

"We urge Umno headquarters to investigate the Kota Melaka Umno Division head as he is believed to be one of those involved in such activities," he said.

Mohamed was reported to have said in Johor Baharu on Monday that divisional leaders had been paid up to RM2 million to carry out subversive activities to topple Dr Mahathir.

Nasir, who is the former head of the Kota Melaka Division, said Umno leaders and members in the country were aware of such activities but did not have details as such activities were carried out subtly.

"If Mohamed Rahmat has the proof it should be made available so that action can be taken," he said.

On allegations against the head of the Kota Melaka Division, Nasir said he had evidence that some people in the division had been involved in organising the reform movement talk by former Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim here on Sept 13.

The Kota Melaka Umno Division head Datuk Amid Nordin had last week expressed his support for Dr Mahathir at a function organised by the division.

Nasir said he and the 20 branch heads were not invited to the function.
