PACIFIC DIALOGUE ENTERS FINAL DAY

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 13 (Bernama) -- The Fourth Pacific Dialogue entered its final day here today with discussion focussing on "Economic and Financial Co-operation: Practical and Substantive Steps".

Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim, who is chairman of the dialogue, is scheduled to hold a news conference later today after closing the two-day event.

The dialogue is organised by the Institute of Strategic and International Studies (Isis) Malaysia, the Institute of Policy Research and the Washington-based Asia Pacific Policy Centre.

The Pacific Dialogue is an annual gathering of prominent regional economic and security experts.

It was opened by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad yesterday. -- BERNAMA
