PARLIAMENT: DR MAHATHIR SAYS ONE POLICE REPORT MADE

KUALA LUMPUR, July 28 (Bernama) -- A police report was made against a corporate figure by entrepreneur Datuk Soh Chee Wen at the Commercial Crimes Investigation Division of Bukit Aman Federal Police, said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

He said the corporate figure named in the report was not a minister's son and also not related in any way with any minister.

As mentioned by the police in the mass media, the matters contained in the report had been referred to the Securities Commission which had the powers to act on them, said Dr Mahathir who is also the Home Minister in a written reply to Lim Guan Eng (DAP-Kota Melaka) in the Dewan Rakyat, here today.

Lim had asked the Home Minister whether investigation had been carried out over police report lodged by Soh of alleged malpractices in the corporate sector.

He also wanted to know the number of police reports made by Soh and whether investigation had been carried out against certain corporate figures including a minister's son named in the report.
