Perak sends tankers to ease problems

IPOH, Tues. - Perak will assist Selangor in whatever way it can to help overcome the water supply problems in the Klang Valley.

Menteri Besar Tan Sri Ramli Ngah Talib said seven water tankers had been sent to the State to help alleviate the problem.

Five tankers belonging to the Perak Water Board were deployed on Sunday while another two belonging to the Ipoh City Council were deployed today.

"Two more tankers will be sent if the need arises," he said today when commenting on the call by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad for all States to help Selangor overcome its water supply problem.
