PM to open new Chung Hua school

Approval for its construction was given by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad a few days before he dissolved Parliament for the general election in 1995.

Come Tuesday (Oct 6), Dr Mahathir is scheduled to declare open this RM6 million project, located at Jalan Sungai Maong, a residential area about five km from the centre of Kuching.

Sarawak Chief Minister Tan Sri Abdul Taib Mahmud performed the ground breaking ceremony on June 30 1996 and work began in earnest.

The 30-classroom SRB Chung Hua No 6 opened its doors on January 5 this year with an initial intake of 393 pupils, comprising 213 boys and 180 girls.

The four-storey structure has a dental clinic, audio visual facilities, conference hall, staff rooms, commerce, music and science laboratory.

The main block of the school has six columns on the facade. It is meant to signify that this is the sixth Chung Hua primary school in the city.
