POSTCARD CAMPAIGN OF NON-SUPPORT TO GERAK

KUANTAN, Oct 12 (Bernama) -- A group of volunteers has taken the initiative to embark on a postcard campaign to express non-support to the Gerak Keadilan Rakyat Malaysia (Gerak).

The group has formed an ad hoc committee for the campaign which will start this month.

Rural Development Minister Datuk Annuar Musa, who told reporters this today, said the group met him recently expressing their intention.

"They plan to send postcards to Gerak leaders, asking them to stop all this hypocrisy that the people are rallying behind them in their struggle," he said, without identifying the group.

Annuar said several activities carried out by Gerak had taken advantage of the people's emotions over certain issues to cloud their judgement.

"With this campaign, the people will have the opportunity to express their objection to Gerak," he said.

Gerak, led by PAS leaders and comprising as members those from the DAP, Parti Rakyat Malaysia (PRM) and some non-governmental organisations (NGOs) is seeking for the so-called justice for the people.

Annuar, who is Kelantan Umno deputy chief, also said all 200,000 Umno members in Kelantan had agreed to send postcards to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, expressing their undivided support to his leadership.

Meanwhile in Jerantut Umno division, more than 2,000 members today pledged full support to Dr Mahathir before his political secretary Datuk Abdul Aziz Shamsuddin at a function.

They also penned their strong objection to the reform movement of former Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim
