Transport-Opening

PUBLIC TRANSPORT FOR BUKIT JALIL'S OPENING

KUALA LUMPUR, July 8 (Bernama) -- Several public transport companies in the city will be providing bus and train services to members of the public wishing to attend the opening ceremony of the Bukit Jalil National Sports Complex on Saturday.

The companies are Sistem Aliran Transit Ringan (LRT-STAR), KTM Komuter, Parkmay Sdn Bhd and Intrakota, Road Transport Department (JPJ) Director-General Datuk Pahamin Rajab told a news conference, here today.

He said LRT-STAR will provide free rides from 3pm to 2am from any of its stations to Bukit Jalil for the opening by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Intrakota buses will depart for Bukit Jalil every 10 minutes while Parkmay buses from Klang and Shah Alam to Bukit Jalil, and from Bukit Jalil to Kuala Lumpur, every 20 minutes.

Pahamin, who is also Commonwealth Games Transport Committee Chairman, said Parkmay will also provide shuttle service from Bandar Tasik Selatan to Bukit Jalil for RM1 while Intrakota from Selangor Turf Club padang to Bukit Jalil, also for RM1.

Buses from Seremban, Bangi and Kajang will discharge their passengers in front of the Petronas station at Malaysian Technology Park for the connecting bus service to Bukit Jalil, he said.

He said KTM Komuter passengers from Port Klang could switch trains at the Kuala Lumpur station and alight at Tasik Selatan station for the LRT-STAR train or bus shuttle service to Bukit Jalil.
