`Reject actions by disloyal groups'

KUALA LUMPUR, Sun. - Barisan Nasional Youth secretary Zulkifli Mohamed Alwi today called on Malaysians to reject the actions of irresponsible groups that were clearly disloyal to the nation. He said such people only had their own interests to pursue.

Zulkifli said BN Youth fully supported Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's statement that Malaysians who criticised the country from abroad had no love for the nation.

Three supporters of former Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim - former Umno Youth assistant secretary Saifuddin Nasution Ismail, former Penang Umno Youth chief Abdul Rahim Ghouse and Anwar's former political secretary Mohamad Ezam Mohd Noor - have been faxing Press statements from Jakarta, Bangkok and Manila.

He said all Malaysians who loved and cherished national sovereignty and independence were invited to participate in BN Youth's Support Malaysia campaign.

It aims to collect messages of love, loyalty and support for the nation from Malaysians via letters, postcards, fax or e-mail.

Zulkifli said: "The majority of Malaysians who have, thus far, remained silent will be able to give a very strong signal to the world that we wish to solve our problems without interference from foreign parties.

"This is timely in view of the mischievous attempt to elicit international support by a small vociferous group which happens to be highlighted by the foreign media."

Zulkifli said the messages had begun to flow in to the campaign secretariat and component parties were also coming up with novel means to express support.

A giant banner to be made by the Selangor BN Youth will be making a bid for inclusion in the Guinness Book of World Records.

The messages should be sent before Oct 24 to be compiled and presented to Dr Mahathir at a later date.
